



CRISIS RESOURCE CENTERS

The Philadelphia Crisis Response Center (CRC) network comprises a series of psychiatric crisis centers. These centers accept walk-ins and are strategically located around the city. In cases of emergency related to mental health or substance use-related crisis, CRCs operate 24/7 and offer emergency evaluations to help determine the most appropriate level of care and services. There are five CRCs available to serve city residents requiring emergency behavioral health services, providing needed care in a safe setting.
